

Far Right Neo-Nazi Group Bombs Germany's Largest Refugee Camp?

A far-right Neo-Nazi group has bombed a refugee camp in Germany, with the loss of thousands of lives. The tents have been flattened, and the survivors traumatized. Bodies litter the destroyed terrain. Survivors wander the ruins, not able to speak the language.

The attackers responsible for the assault have been known for its extremist rhetoric. Germany investigated the group and has traced it back to the Czech Republic.
